 Maintain control of hazardous chemicals, substances, and waste within area of responsibility.
- Conduct performance reviews. Recommend employee status changes to include hiring, termination, promotion, and salary changes.
- Maintain current knowledge of all Asheville Regional Airport regulations relating to areas of responsibility.
- Ensures compliance with all applicable Federal and State regulations for DPS.
- Acts as an Assistant Airport Security Coordinator and oversees the Airport Security Program.
- Assist with management and implementation of the Airport Emergency Plan.
- Acts as the Assistant Terminal Agency Coordinator for the NC DCI system.
- Oversees all investigative matters that are not left to the originating officer.
- Oversees training, certification compliance, recertification, and various travel within the department.
- Performs Law Enforcement, Firefighting, Aircraft Rescue and Firefighting and Emergency Medical Response duties.

- Must pass initial and random drug screening and background investigation.
- Ability to operate professionally and effectively in high pressure situations.
- Ability to manage multiple projects simultaneously and meet deadlines.
- Must pass airfield driver training program and proficiently operate motor vehicles, apparatus and other equipment within the secured portions of the airport facility and Movement Areas.

Supervisory Responsibility

Responsible for supervising the day-to-day operations of the Public Safety Department, including Lieutenants, Public Safety Officers and Firefighters. Delegates duties and responsibilities as appropriate.

Certifications Required

- Basic Law Enforcement Training (BLET) certification in North Carolina or other jurisdiction recognized by the State of North Carolina.
- Federal Aviation Administration Aircraft Rescue Firefighter 40 hour basic course certification.
- Firefighter II certification.
- EMT certification in North Carolina, or another jurisdiction recognized by the State of North Carolina.
- National Incident Management System (NIMS) course completion/certifications through ICS 400.

Latitude/Independent Judgment/Accuracy

The Public Safety Captain works with general direction from the Public Safety Chief and operates with a great degree of individual latitude. He/she utilizes independent judgment in making decisions on a routine basis involving all facets of Public Safety operations, and is responsible for making decisions based upon sound judgment, knowledge of organizational policies and procedures, and with a high degree of accuracy.

Working Conditions

The position works in a variety of settings, environments and climates. Must be available to work or be on call 24 hours per day and work additional hours when required for routine or emergency situations. Requires frequent movement from one work location to another over uneven and varying surfaces. Must possess tolerance to standing, sitting and highly physical activities. Conditions may require extremely hazardous situations involving fire, chemical or criminal activity, and is subject to loud noises. May encounter extreme stress, and the requirement to make life and death decisions. Must be able to wear appropriate personal protective clothing and equipment under hazardous conditions, including the use of SCBA.
