- North Concourse: Temporary power is scheduled to be turned on in December. This will allow for the startup of mechanical equipment, and conditioned air in the spaces where finishes will be installed.
- **Baggage Handling System:** The conveyor and equipment installations are progressing.
- Air Traffic Control Tower: The steel tower cab is scheduled to be installed early December. The Base Building is progressing with mechanical equipment installations.

Holiday travel tips

It's hard to believe that the holidays are already here! If you're flying this holiday season, be sure to check out these travel tips to make your trip easy as (pumpkin) pie.

- Arrive at least 2 hours before your boarding time: Be sure to arrive at least two hours before your flight's boarding time, not the flight's departure time. Boarding times vary depending on the airline and flight but are generally 30-50 minutes before departure (check your boarding pass). This is especially important during the busy holiday travel season.
- Make a plan for parking and ground transportation: Before you arrive at the airport, make a plan for parking. You can find helpful parking information, including maps, rates and live parking numbers, on AVL's website. Also, consider planning ahead for ground transportation so that you can get you where you need to go after your flight. Whether it's arranging for someone to pick you up, renting a car, or pre-arranging a ride app or taxi pick up, take care of the details before your flight takes off.
- **Stay connected:** Keep track of any updates or flight changes by downloading your airline's app. Another helpful tip is to check out your destination airport's website for valuable information. Flyavl.com has all you need to know about flying through AVL!
- Know the busy days: The holidays can be a busy time to travel, but some days are busier than others. Flying on the actual holiday day tends to be quieter than the surrounding days.

The Transportation Security Administration (TSA) releases holiday travel predictions that can help you see which days are predicted to be the busiest, and plan accordingly.

You may fly with festive pie. However, spreadable items like jams, jellies, and cranberry sauce need to go in a checked bag. Remember that the TSA liquids policy also applies to items like snow globes. Be sure to pack your snow globe (or any other liquids larger than 3.4oz.) in a checked bag!

Consider wrapping your presents when you reach your destination. This will help with the screening process at TSA if your items need to be inspected.


