





2021 WAS A YEAR OF SIGNIFICANT RECOVERY FOR ASHEVILLE REGIONAL AIRPORT

MORE GROWTH ON THE HORIZON

The numbers are in, and Asheville Regional Airport (AVL) served 1.42 million annual passengers in 2021, which is 88% of 2019 (the airport's record year), and 25% ahead of 2018 (the first year the airport served more than 1 million annual passengers). Specifically, 1,428,266 passengers utilized a commercial flight at AVL last year, on one of these five airlines: Allegiant, American, Delta, Sun Country and United.

2021 was a year of recovery from the devastating impact of COVID-19, not only on the airport and airlines that serve our region, but on airports and airlines worldwide. Rebounded passenger numbers began in May 2021, and the airport experienced a record summer and achieved a new record month of passenger utilization in July 2021.

"The first thing I want to do is thank our local travelers for choosing to fly from AVL as they headed back to the skies," said Lew Bleiweis, A.A.E., Executive Director. "And second, I want to thank our airline partners who have continued serving our region in significant ways, even during the major downturn in 2020. The airlines are truly vested in our region, and we are continually grateful for the incredible air service we have and the airlines who provide it."

And there's more growth on the horizon.
