SHUTTLE LOT SOUTH NOW OPEN

The new Shuttle Lot South is open in time for the holiday travel season! The Shuttle Lot South is located near the Marathon gas station, across from the WNC AG center with an entrance on Rental Car Road.

This lot has 600 spaces (500 currently open) and is continually serviced by the airport shuttles.

There is still some work to be done on the north end of the lot, including an entrance on Terminal Drive, that is expected to be completed in the first quarter of 2024.

ARRIVE AT LEAST TWO HOURS BEFORE BOARDING

With increased volume due to holiday travel, AVL would like to remind everyone to **arrive at least two hours before your flight boards,** instead of two hours prior to departure time. Boarding times vary depending on the airline and flight but are generally 30-50 minutes before departure (check your boarding pass). While AVL always advises arriving two hours early, it is more important than ever.

Two hours prior to boarding allows plenty of time to park, check-in and get through security before making your way to your gate. No one wants the stress of having to rush because you are in danger of missing your flight. And if you arrive at your gate early, you can check out some of the amenities AVL offers including the Blue Ridge Tavern and Trading, Cinnabon, Auntie Annes and Aletitude. CONTRACTOR REACHES 100,000 MAN HOURS!



AVL Forward is the biggest, most significant infrastructure project ever undertaken at AVL, which will result in a completely new airport terminal for western North Carolina.

A big milestone occurred this month: Hensel Phelps, our construction firm, documented 100,000 man-hours worked. We have many more hundreds of thousands of work hours to go, but big strides have already been made toward our new terminal.

Here's what's happening now:

- Our central energy plant is oh-soclose! Interior finishing continues, and the underground utility connection work is underway.
- Next month, travelers will see more construction walls go up in the terminal. We're closing half of our





- **ticket lobby**, and the north end will soon be demolished to make way for new construction.
- Next month, you will also see the rental car counters move from baggage claim to the lower level (Level 1) of the garage to make way for new construction. And yes, a construction wall will go up in the south end of baggage claim so the construction team can get started there.
- And, of course, work continues on the new north concourse. We're anticipating the placement of structural steel to begin early in the new year – stay tuned for news about that milestone!


