TSA CHECKPOINT #TheMoreYouKnow

Helpful amenities for travelers at AVL

Big changes have taken place at AVL recently. As part of the completion of the North Concourse, the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) checkpoint was relocated. This location allows for construction to continue onto the next phase of the AVL Forward project. Did you know that the TSA at AVL offers several helpful amenities for travelers?







TSA PreCheck: A frequent question from travelers is if a TSA PreCheck lane is available at AVL, and the answer is yes! Travelers enrolled in this program will experience an easier screening process and shorter wait times. Be sure to look for the TSA PreCheck lane at AVL if you are a member and check out the TSA website if you are interested in enrolling.

Special assistance and stroller lane: AVL has a dedicated lane for passengers in need of special assistance, like those in wheelchairs or passengers with children in strollers.

TSA Cares: This program provides detailed information and support for passengers who may need additional assistance with the screening process, such as those with disabilities and medical conditions. The program includes an option to request the help of a TSA Passenger Support Specialist who can provide assistance through the security screening process. RENTAL CAR COUNTERS RELOCATION



With the completion of the North Concourse, work is continuing into Phase 2 of AVL Forward. This next phase will include the southern expansion of the baggage claim area as well as the construction of the South Concourse. To accommodate this work, the rental car counters have relocated from the modular units to a temporary location in the Legacy Terminal's ticket lobby – see map. The rental car pick-up/drop-off points will remain in the parking garage directly across the street from the terminal and key drop boxes will remain in the parking garage and baggage claim.

EFFICIENCY AND INGENUITY

How AVL is adding efficiency to the airport experience

Phase I of AVL Forward, the new North Concourse, has been open for two months and many have been able to experience the beautiful design elements and much-needed space. Aside from aesthetics, the North Concourse is full of ingenious ways that AVL is working to bring efficiency to the airport experience. Take a look at some of these streamlined approaches that can be seen and experienced along your journey:

• Cleaning robots: It's good that the AVL Forward project is space-themed, because it feels like we are living in the future. With a lot more space to clean in the North Concourse, our hard-working custodial team is receiving assistance from some high-tech tools. There are two automated cleaning machines that help to keep the beautiful terrazzo floors and carpets in good shape. These helpful cleaning robots amazingly avoid running into objects (and people) as they go about their task.

- Energy efficient glass: The new concourse is full of glass, making way for stellar mountain views. These windows use electrochromic glazing that automatically tints based on the outside light, which helps to save energy and power, while keeping passengers comfortable as they enjoy the gorgeous natural beauty of our region.
- **Escalators:** This may seem like a small thing, but the new escalators conveniently convey passengers from the TSA screening checkpoint to the North Concourse's second level where the gates are located. There is an elevator located right next to the escalator for those who need (or prefer) it.
- **Digital lost and found system:** AVL's Guest Services recently upgraded to a digital lost and found system. This will make logging and searching for lost items faster and more convenient. The program has features like convenient shipping options and a digital lost item form passengers can fill out.

These are just a few new ways AVL is bringing efficiency to the airport experience, making the passenger journey more enjoyable.

We've had a lot of great feedback and questions come through about the new concession offerings in the new North Concourse – here is the real answer to your real questions.

Much like the building of the new terminal, our full concession offerings for AVL Forward will be coming in phases. The five new North Concourse concessions that opened in June are part of a bigger program that will continue to grow in local offerings and variety, including a full-service sit-down restaurant. The five new concessions – Aletitude, The Goods@AVL, Costa Coffee, Jimmy John's and Tropical Smoothie Café – currently utilize and feature over 30 local purveyor's items. Examples include Mountain Merch, Ella B Candles, French Broad Chocolates, Bears Smokehouse, Culloweegee Farms and many more. These first five concessions, plus the extended vending offerings, include a variety of hot and cold food and beverage options. In the mornings you can find warm breakfast options at Jimmy John's and Tropical Smoothie Café such as egg sandwiches, breakfast flatbreads and breakfast wraps, as well as fresh fruit topped smoothie bowls to fuel your travel day. The local employees that operate and serve you at each of these concessions are excited to see you the next time you fly!


