AVL 2024 RUNWAY 5K REGISTRATION NOW OPEN

Register now for the August 17 event

Asheville Regional Airport (AVL) will host its annual Runway 5K on Saturday, August 17, where runners and walkers will make their way down Taxiway Bravo while planes take off and land on the adjacent runway. All participants must pre-register. The race is limited to 1,000 participants and past events have sold out.

To guarantee a race t-shirt, participants must register no later than 9pm August 6. After that, t-shirts are available while supplies last. Race registration will close 9pm August 14.

The Runway 5K raises funds to support local aviation scholarships administered by both A-B Tech Department of Aviation and the Western North Carolina Pilots Association Educational Foundation. AVL will also share proceeds with Big Brothers Big Sisters of WNC.

The event will take place on the north end of the airfield, with parking in a nearby area. All participants will be shuttled to the event site, which is in a secure area near the airfield.

Food trucks offering coffee, pastries and donuts will be at the event, as well as music, merchandise, special photo opportunities and more.

TAKE A LOOK AT THE PROGRESS WE'VE MADE TOWARD A NEW PASSENGER TERMINAL FOR YOU!



- The new north concourse is fully framed and it is impressive! (You can't miss it when you drive by the airport this new concourse will house seven gates and is scheduled to open in June 2025.)
- There is a lot of prep work
 happening along the front curb of
 the airport, so be aware as you drive
 in to pick up or drop off
 passengers. Some lanes are
 temporarily closed, and construction
 barriers are in place.
- Baggage Claim is one of the next areas that will undergo additional demolition and construction. Rental car counters are moving from inside Baggage Claim to an area just outside of Baggage Claim. This move will happen later this month. We'll have signage directing passengers to a covered walkway that will lead directly to the rental car counters in a covered area outside.
