MODULAR BUILDINGS COMING SOON

Temporary gate areas will open in March

We're continuing to get ready for our huge and historic terminal expansion project. There's a lot of "make-ready" work that must be done first before we can officially break ground.

One significant milestone is the installation of modular buildings that we will use as gate hold rooms for a few years. They are on order and scheduled to arrive next month. Then, they will be upfitted for use. We anticipate opening these temporary hold rooms in March 2023. The use of temporary gates all in one wing will allow us to shift all aircraft arrivals and departures to the south concourse so we can close the north concourse for demolition.

We still have a few big steps to take before major demolition and construction can begin, including ensuring that all financing is in order and that the final cost estimate is manageable. The timing for these decisions is approaching soon, and our hope is that we can move forward with our official groundbreaking in spring 2023.

In the meantime, our make-ready work means that once we can begin construction, we will be able to maintain the same square footage that we have now to accommodate passengers – located a little differently – with an equal number of operational gates (which is seven). We estimate that these temporary gate areas will be in use for about two years.

Record annual passengers projected for 2022

The official numbers won't be in for a few weeks, but it's clear that more travelers than ever before flew to and from AVL in 2022. We have enjoyed the hustle and bustle and are up for the challenge to continue to grow to meet your needs.
